Today, as Stericycle stockholders meet in Chicago, we are holding a protest outside Stericycle facilities across the country.

Why? What has this medical waste company done to warrant a protest?

Stericycle partners with Planned Parenthood, the nation's largest abortion chain.

Planned Parenthood performs over 330,000 abortions every year—more than 35% of all abortions in the U.S. Abortion is Planned Parenthood's largest source of clinic revenue.

By providing medical waste services for Planned Parenthood, Stericycle is aiding and abetting the wanton destruction of human life in its earliest, most vulnerable days—including the harvesting of aborted babies' body parts for medical research.

Moreover, Stericycle is directly involved in abortion by disposing of fetal remains.

Irrefutable evidence shows that Stericycle is violating its own company policy by continuing to pick up and dispose of the

bodies of aborted children. The States of Ohio and South Carolina have even charged Stericycle with improperly disposing of these remains. As recently as February 2019, an investigation by the State of Georgia established that Stericycle is disposing of fetal remains there.

The value of Stericycle stock has dropped significantly in recent years.

Is the growing public awareness of Stericycle's relationship with Planned Parenthood to blame? Will pro-life practitioners—including religiously affiliated hospital networks—be willing to contract services from Stericycle if the company remains involved with Planned Parenthood and their abortion business?

It's time for Stericycle to DUMP Planned Parenthood.

Planned Parenthood has become a lightning rod of controversy over abortion, harvesting fetal tissue, defrauding state governments, setting "abortion quotas" at their centers, and more. Stericycle: DUMP Planned Parenthood.
